



Non-essential Businesses that are **NOT** allowed to remain open.

For the purpose of this regulation, non-essential businesses have been identified as businesses that present the most risk in the Country's ability to be able to manage the spread of COVID-19. The businesses listed below **will not be allowed** to open during the mentioned period in the Regulation. This includes, but is not limited to:

Educational Institutes <i>(remote/ e-learning & Special arrangements are allowed)</i>	Recreational Activities
Day Care Centers	Casinos (stand-alone and hotel-based)
Early Childhood Development Institutes	Night Clubs & other dance establishments
Schools	Adult Entertainment Establishments
Universities	Art galleries and other exhibition halls
Training facilities	Recreational centers
Retail of Goods	The Cinema
Retail stores (clothing, jewelry and souvenirs)	Businesses offering recreational activities, such as zip-lining, boat trips, quads etc.
Sales outlets and Shopping centers	Gyms and other (indoor and outdoor) sports facilities
Vending stalls at the Philipsburg markets	Museum(s)
Food & Beverages (no dining-in/ loitering)	Hair & Nail Salons
Bars	Barbershops
Roadside vendors (take-out and delivery services are allowed)	Meetings & Events
Bakeries (take-out and delivery services are allowed)	Conference facilities
Restaurants incl. those situated at hotels (take-out and delivery services are allowed)	Outdoor establishments that accommodate events
